3) Escape from Legalism

'But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is Christ therefore a minister of sin? Certainly not!' (Galatians 2:17) 'For if I build again those things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor' (Galatians 2:18)

`For I through the law died to the law that I might live to God' (Galatians 2:19)

'I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me' (Galatians 2:20) 'I do not set aside the grace of God; for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died in vain' (Galatians 2:21) 'But now after you have known God, or rather are known by God, how is it that you turn again to the weak and beggarly elements, to which you desire again to be in bondage? You observe days and months and seasons and years'

(Galatians 4:9-10)

' Have I therefore become your enemy because I tell you the truth?' (Galatians 4:16)

'My little children, for whom I labor in birth again until Christ is formed in you' (Galatians 4:19) ' But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another' (Galatians 5:15) *Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another'* (Galatians 5:26)

'For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself ' (Galatians 6:3) 'As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, (Galatians 6:12) 'O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as crucified? (Galatians 3:1) 'Have you suffered so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain' (Galatians 3:4) 'This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh' (Galatians 3:2-3)

'As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him' (Colossians 2:6)

' O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you ' (Galatians 3:1)

'Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage' (Galatians 5:1) You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace' (Galatians 5:4)
