8) Grace Reigns

'the law entered that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more'

(Rom. 5:20)

'What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?' (Rom. 6:1-2) 'if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ'

(Rom. 5:17)

'as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord' (Rom. 5:21)

'to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God'

(Acts 26:18)

'He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love' (Col. 1:13)

'For the death that He died, He died to sin once' (Rom. 6:10)

'And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was' (John 17:5)

'we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body' (Rom. 8:23)

'So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the Lord had said to Moses; and Joshua gave it as an inheritance to Israel according to their divisions by their tribes.

Then the land rested from war'

(Joshua 11:23)

'Now Joshua was old, advanced in years. And the Lord said to him: "You are old, advanced in years, and there remains very much land yet to be possessed.
