

The Blessing of Abraham

1) Blessed to be a Blessing

*'Then God blessed them,
and God said to them, "Be
fruitful and multiply;
(Genesis 1:28)*

***"In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be
blessed"***

(Gen.18:18; Gen.22:18; Gen26:4; Gen.28:14)

'And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, "In you all the nations shall be blessed." So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham...'

***"...that the blessing of Abraham might come
upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we
might receive the promise of the Spirit
through faith"
(Gal. 3:8-9,14)***

"Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus"

(Gal. 3:13&14)

***"...God was in Christ reconciling the world
to Himself, not imputing their trespasses
to them..."***
(2 Cor. 5:19)

***"Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are
forgiven,
And whose sins are covered;
Blessed is the man to whom the Lord shall not
impute sin."
(Rom. 4:7&8)***

***"For I will be merciful to their
unrighteousness, and their sins and their
lawless deeds I will remember no more"
(Heb. 8:12)***
