(1 Sam.18:4)

'So the women sang as they danced, and said: "Saul has slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands." Then Saul was very angry, and the saying displeased him; and he said, "They have ascribed to David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed only thousands. Now what more can he have but the kingdom?" So Saul eyed David from that day forward'

The devil's wisdom

'But if you have bitter envy and selfseeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic' (Jas.3:14-15) 'I will ascend into the heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north; I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High' (Isa.14:12-14)

'a tree desirable to make one wise' (Gen.3:6)

'For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there' (James 3:16)

'Now Saul was afraid of David, because the Lord was with him, but had departed from Saul'

(1 Sam.18:12)

'And it happened on the next day that the distressing spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied inside the house. So David played music with his hand, as at other times; but there was a spear in Saul's hand and Saul cast the spear, for he said, "I will pin David to the wall!" But David escaped his presence twice'

(1 Sam.18:10-11)

'Then Saul said to David, "Here is my older daughter Merab; I will give her to you as a wife. Only be valiant for me, and fight the LORD's battles." For Saul thought, "Let my hand not be against him, but let the hand of the Philistines be against him'
(1 Sam.18:17)
