The Kingdom of God, Then 5) Watchful Leaders 'Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming' (Matt.24:42) *'Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming'* (Matt.25:13)

'Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour' (1 Pet.5:8) 'Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die' (Rev.3:2)

'Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his master made ruler over his household, to give them food in due season? Blessed is that servant whom his master, when he comes, will find so doing. Assuredly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all his goods' (Matt.24:45-47)

'And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward, but Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end' (Heb.3:5-6)

'Remember those who <u>rule</u> over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct' (Heb.13:7)

'Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you' (Heb.13:17)

'...how I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and taught you publicly and from house to house...For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God' (Acts 20:20) *'With many parables He spoke the Word to them as they were able to hear it'* (Mk.4:33)

'I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now' (John 16:12)

. '...and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away' (1 Pet.5:4)

'But if that evil servant says in his heart, "My master is delaying his coming", and begins to beat his fellow servants, and to eat and drink with the drunkards, the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him and at an hour that he is not aware of...' (Matt.24:48-49)

"...our authority, which the Lord gave us for edification and not for your destruction" (2 Cor.10:8)

Not that we have dominion over your faith' (2 Cor.1:24)

'Now, I Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ' (2 Cor.10:1&2) 'Preach the Word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching' (2 Tim.4:2) 'It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery'
(Gal.5:1)

'Only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to one, "Go," and he goes; and to another, "Come," and he comes; and to my servant, "Do this," and he does it'

(Matt.8:8-9)

<u>True spiritual authority is characterized by:</u>

1) A servant heart

'But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant' (Matt.20:25-26) 2) A gentle spirit

'We were gentle among you, just as a nursing mother cherishes her own children' (1 Thes.2:7)

3) And an exemplary life

'Let no one despise your youth, but <u>be</u> <u>an example</u> to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity' (1 Tim.4:12)

'Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by constraint but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but <u>being examples</u> to the flock'

(1 Pet.5:2-3)

'... and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites. There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth' (Matt.24:51)
